## INTAKE OFFICER'S ADVICE TO A DELINQUENT CHILD AND PARENT, GUARDIAN OR CUSTODIAN

You are hereby advised of the following rights:

- 1. You have a right to know the nature of allegations against said child;
- 2. The undersigned intake/probation officer is conducting a preliminary inquiry to assist the prosecutor in determining whether a petition should be filed alleging that said child is a delinquent child:
- 3. The undersigned intake officer will recommend whether to file a petition, informally adjust the case, or refer the child to another agency;
- 4. Said child has a right to remain silent, anything he/she says may be used against him/her in subsequent judicial proceedings, he/she has a right to consult with an attorney and to stop talking with the intake officer at any time;
- 5. If said child cannot afford an attorney, the Court will appoint one for him/her; and
- 6. The parent, guardian or custodian may dispute any allegations made at the Dispositional or other hearing concerning their participation or may controvert any allegations concerning their financial responsibility for any services that would be provided.

You are further advised that the parents, guardian or custodian of the child may be subjected to the following for the delinquent child:

- 1. The parent, guardian or custodian may be required to participate in a program of care, treatment, or rehabilitation for the child; and
- 2. The parent or guardian of the child may be held financially responsible for any services provided for the child including the services of court appointed counsel.
