Election Board meeting held in the Connie Lamar room on November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 11 a.m. Meeting was recorded. Brian Jones, Becky McClure and Clerk Bruder all were present along with members of the public.

Three things were on the agenda. First, provisional ballots. Two were submitted. One was denied due to not being registered in Boone County, and the second one was granted because the voter should have been allowed to vote on a machine and there was an error on the poll worker.

Secondly, fees from late CFA-4 filings. Republican Party requested to be continued until the next hearing. Brian requested a motion to grant request, Becky second motion; all members were in favor (3-0). Tonya Thayer requested a waiver due to only being a few minutes late. Brian Jones made the motion to waive; Becky seconded motion. All members in favor (3-0). Lauren Hernandez-deCrane was notified and did not show up or file a response. Clerk Bruder made motion to file a small claim against Ms. Hernandez-deCrane. Brian second motion, and all members voted in favor (3-0)

The third and final item was a presentation by Indiana First Action, represented by Mr. Eric Kraus, a member and a Boone County Citizen. Mr. Kraus was advised and questioned if he would be using the full 15 minutes allotted, and he stated that was an ample amount of time and if any time left was over, someone else could speak. Mr. Kraus exceeding his allotted time but was graciously allowed to finish his statement.

No public questions or comments were permitted.

Brian Jones motioned for the meeting to be adjourned and Becky seconded motion. All members were in favor (3-0).
