The Boone County Election Board met in the office of the Boone County Clerk on June 21, 2024. The meeting was called to Order by Chairman Becky McClure at 9:00 a.m.

Clerk Bruder brought to the Board's attention that in submitting the Certification of Primary Election results two typographical errors occurred. Candidate for Delegate to the Republican State Convention, Don Kenna, was reported to have received 3001 votes when in fact he received 301 votes. The number of votes cast for Becky Cash and Brian Cash, each also seeking election as State Convention Delegates, were transposed. These errors have been corrected and the duly-elected convention delegates were notified and attended the convention.

The Election Board adopted a plan calling for all inspectors at voting sites to notify the Clerk immediately if during early voting an absentee ballot is dropped off at the vote center at which the inspector is working. A person designated by the Board will pick up that absentee ballot in a timely manner and transport it to the Clerk's Office where it will be stored with other absentee ballots until election day when it will be counted. Motion to accept this plan was made by Becky McClure and seconded by Brian Jones. Motion passed unanimously.

The Boone County Election Board also adopted a resolution that calls for the Clerk to provide a copy of the full County Voter Registration List and SVRS Reports as part of her response to any public records request per I.C. 3-7-27-6. Brian Jones moved to adopt said resolution. Becky McClure seconded that motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Clerk Bruder moved to adjourn. Brian Jones seconded that motion. Meeting was adjourned.
