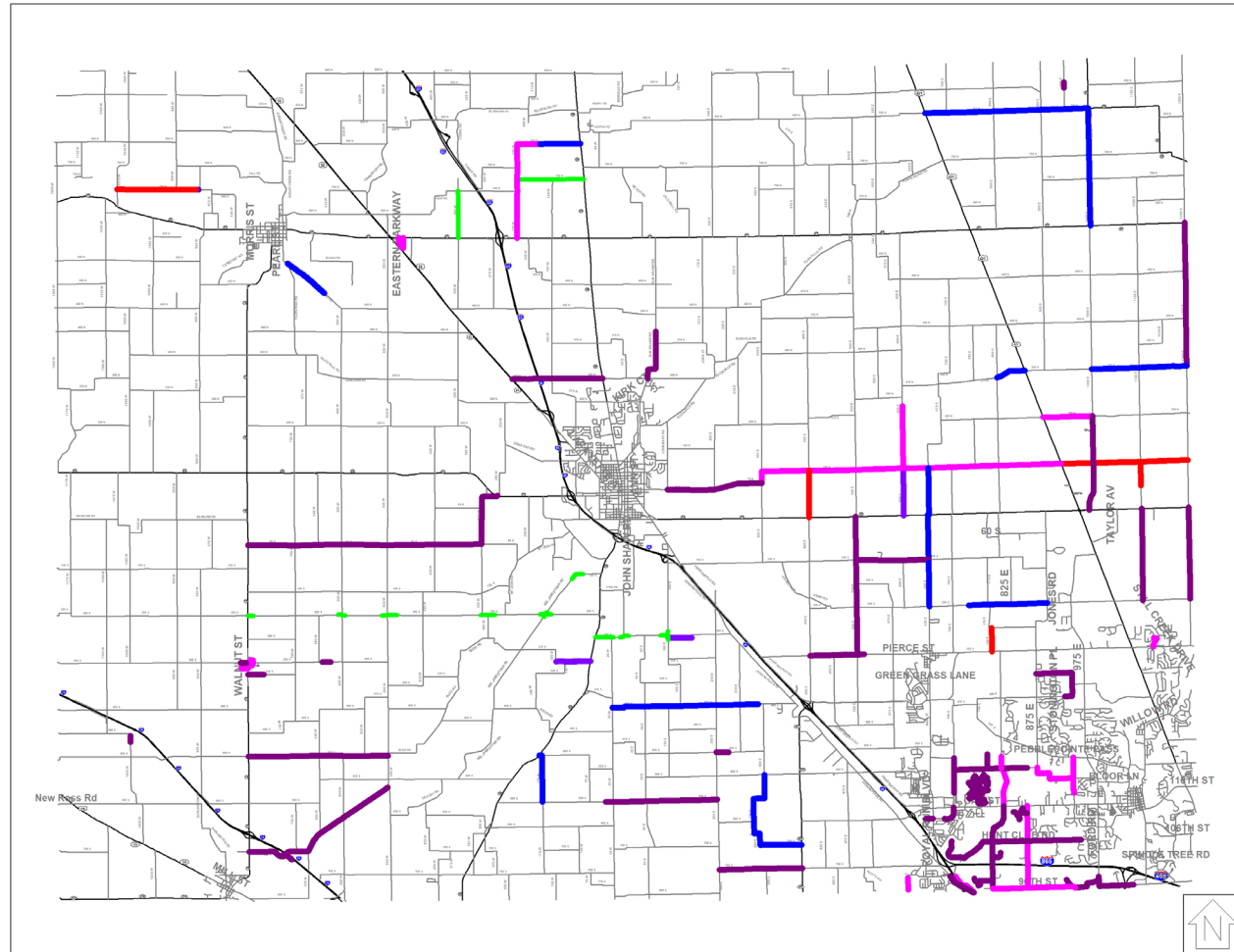

 - Add high friction surface treatment



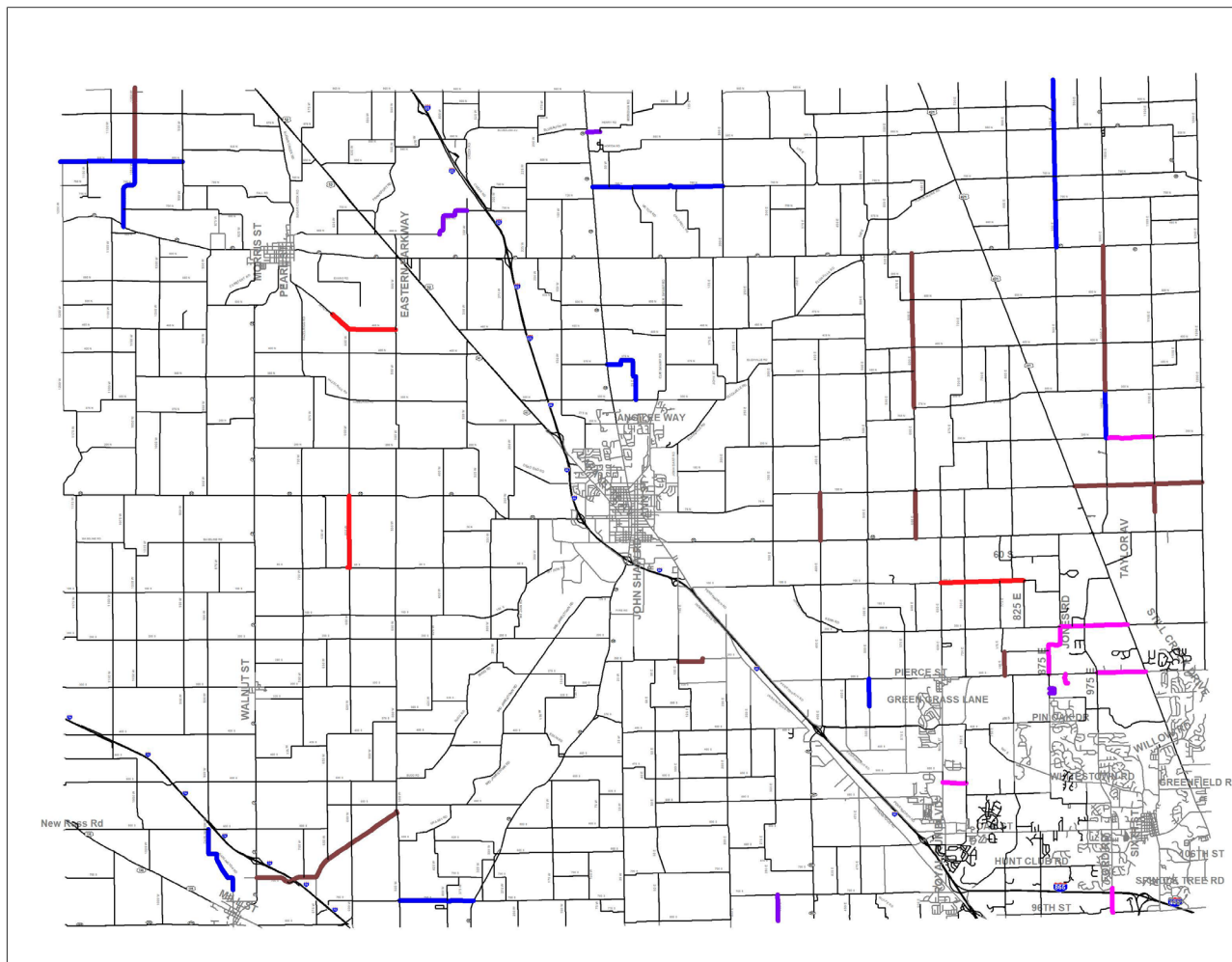

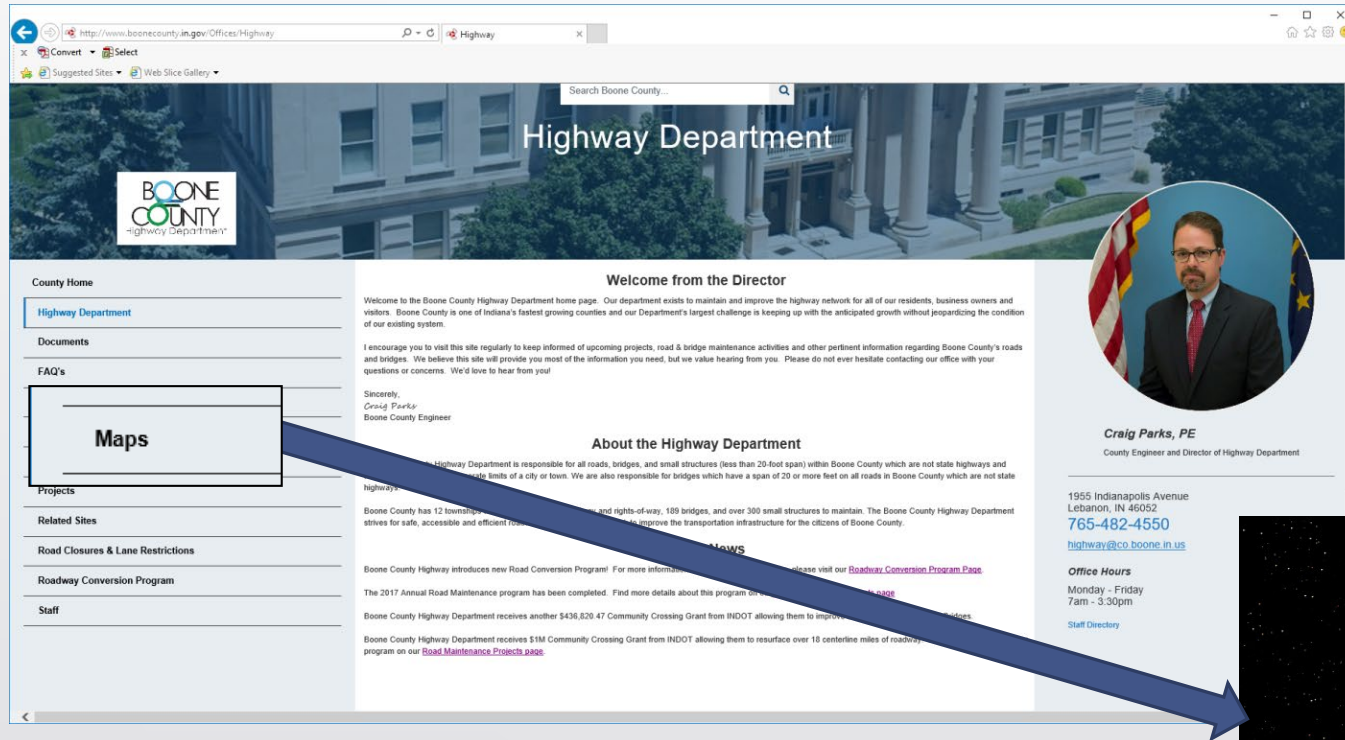
